CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS

1945
 August 6 Hiroshima atom bombed. Dead: 80,000 in the first minute.
 August 9 Nagasaki: 75,000 dead.

1949
 September 23 Announcement of Russian atom bomb explosion.

1950
 February 3 Dr. Klaus Fuchs confesses to atomic espionage for Soviet Union.
 May 23 Harry Gold confesses to being Fuch's American link in spy ring.
 June 15 David Greenglass arrested as Gold's accomplice.
 June 25 Korean War begins.
 July 17 Julius Rosenberg arrested as co-conspirator with Gold and Greenglass.
 August 11 Ethel Rosenberg arrested on the same charge as her husband.
 August 18 Morton Sobell arrested as co-conspirator.

1951
 March 6 Rosenberg-Sobell spy ring trial begins.
 April 5 Julius and Ethel Rosenberg sentenced to death.
 Morton Sobell sentenced to thirty years.

1953
 February 11 President Eisenhower denies clemency.
 June 19 Many courts and appeals later (the record of the trial was never reviewed by the Supreme Court), Julius and Ethel Rosenberg are executed at 8:02 pm and 8:08 pm, respectively.

1969
 January 14 Morton Sobell is paroled.
